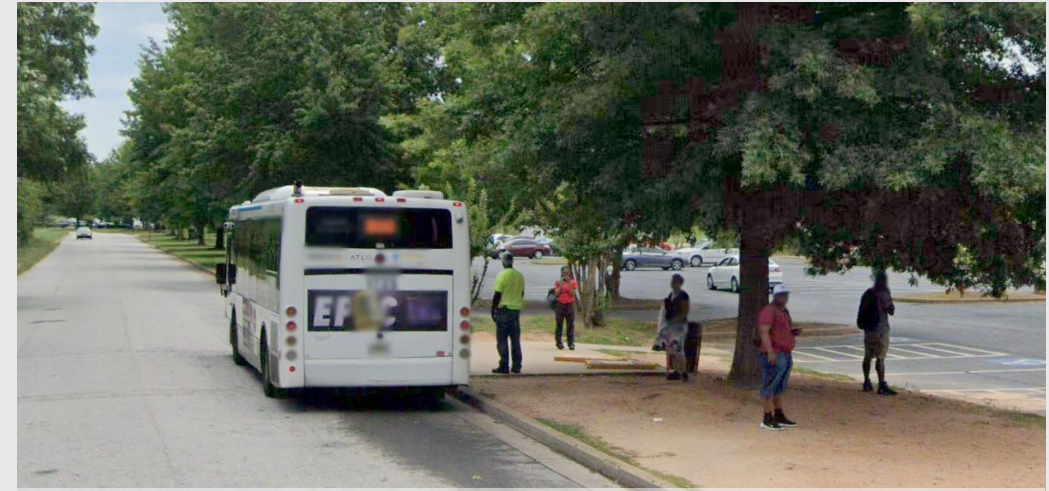

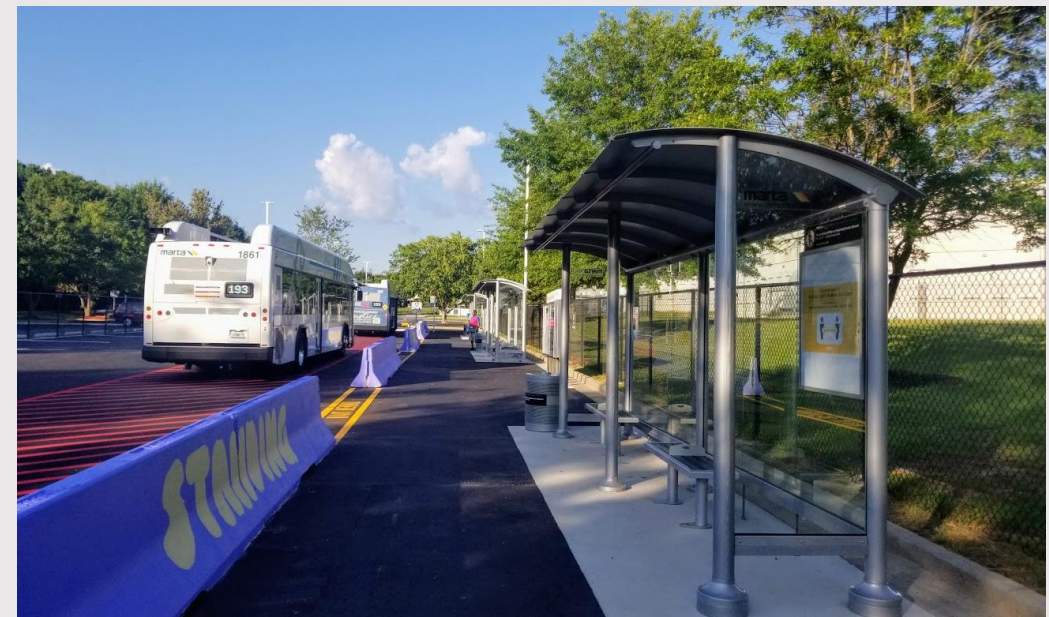
First/last mile connections

Justice Center Hub

- Two-phase approach
- Phase 1: Quick-build project
 - Moved stop off-street
 - Larger boarding area with shelters and passenger info
 - Dedicated bus-only area
 - Dedicated area for park & ride, ridesharing, kiss/ride
 - Public art
- Phase 2: Permanent transit hub

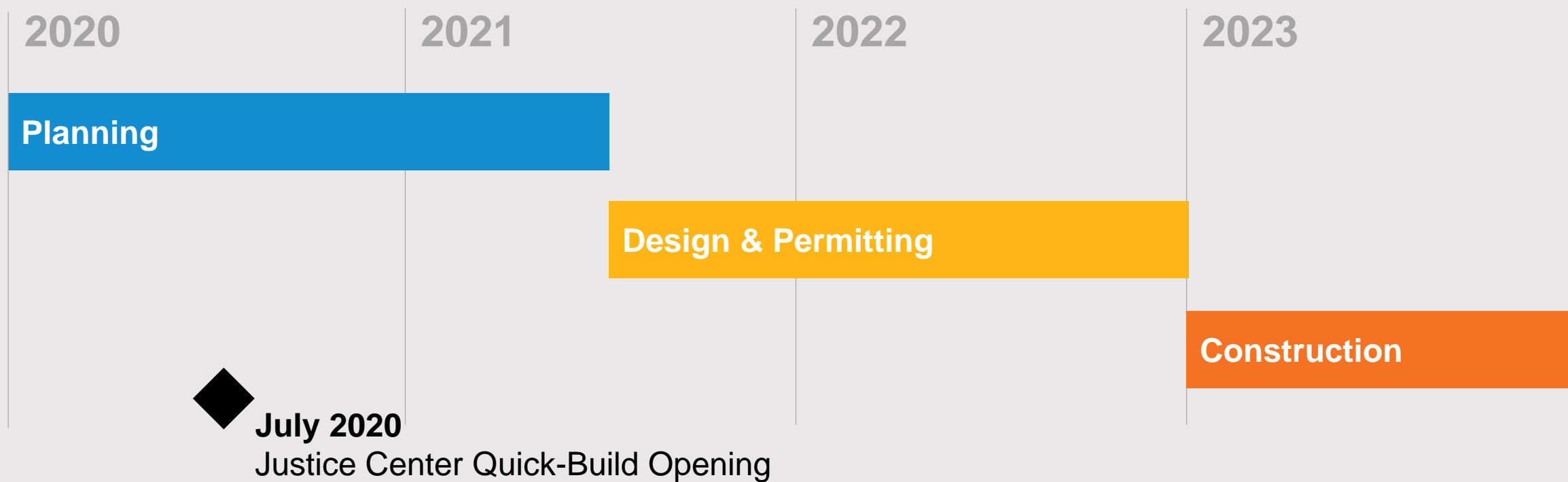


Stonecrest Transit Hub
